**9:008:30 EXECUTIVE SESSION**

**The Board met in Executive Session prior** to this meeting for the purpose of discussing a personnel matter with respect to administrative employees.

**The meeting began with a role call of the Board members** to verify that a quorum was present. All Board members were in attendance. Mrs. Boujoukos was elected temporary president for the purpose of electing officers.

The Board conducted their election of officers. **Mrs. Maureen Grosheider was elected President and Mr. Hubert was elected Vice President.**

Mrs. Grosheider made some brief comments thanking her colleagues for the confidence they vested in her and Mr. Hubert as demonstrated by electing them to Board leadership. She also detailed some of the highlights of the last three years under the leadership of Mrs. Bishop as Board President. She complimented Mrs. Bishop's dedication and outstanding accomplishments on behalf of the District.

Mr. Hubert also thanked the Board for their support over the last eight years and offered his on-going support to the administrators. He thanked Mrs. Bishop for her leadership as President.

**The celebrated 50-member North Allegheny High School Honors Chamber Choir** proceeded to honor the Board with musical selections under the direction of Ernest M. Pontiere. They presented a classical piece, a jazz piece, a pop piece and a holiday finale. When the students had concluded their musical selections, Mrs. Grosheider acknowledged the high quality of the choral program, the incredible growth the choral program has experienced under Mr. Pontiere's leadership, and the tremendous pride the District takes in having these outstanding young musicians represent our award-winning arts program.

After a brief break, Mrs. Grosheider proceeded with the Reorganization Meeting to elect Mr. Schwartzmier and Mrs. Ludwig as representatives to A. W. Beattie. For the most part, the current report assignments were maintained, with the exception of the finance report – which was assigned to Mrs. Bishop. Mrs. Ludwig will be the Protocol Officer for the coming year. Mr. Shuckrow will now work with the Foundation, with Mrs. Boujoukos as the alternate. Mr. Cunningham will continue to work with the Golf Outing. Mr. Shuckrow will continue to do the legislative report, with Mr. Cunningham as the alternate. Mrs. Bishop will be the PSBA liaison. Mr. Schwartzmier will be the representative to the Hall of Fame and Mr. Pagone will continue to work with the Summer Recreation Program.
