**SPECIAL MEETING/WORK SESSION**

**UPDATE ON SUMMER CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

Dr. Green explained that this is an annual event in which construction projects that have been prioritized and approved through the 2009/2010 Capital Funding Plan have been completed over the summer.

**Mr. Rob Gaertner**, Director of Facilities, thanked the Board for approving the significant number of projects that were addressed this summer. The total value of construction contracts that were awarded toward the ongoing maintenance of District facilities was \$1,735,897.

These projects were included:

- Roof Replacement at IES
- Replacement of the Freezer and Reconfiguration of the Loading Dock at NAI
- Installation of Lights for the Baseball and Softball Fields at NASH
- Paving and Sidewalk Replacement at NAI
- Paving Replacement at BWE, MES and MMS
- Replacement of the Carpeting at NASH
- Installation of Exterior Cameras at MMS and IMS
- Installation of Exterior Door Numbers at CMS/CAO, IMS, FES, HES, IES, MES, McK, and PES
- Replace 2 Rooftop AC Units at MES and 5 Units at MMS
- Concrete Sidewalk and Curb Repairs at FES, HES, IES, McK, CMS, and Newman Stadium
- Driveway and Parking Lot Repairs at FES, HES, IES, McK and Transportation

**SPECIAL EDUCATION AND PUPIL SERVICES REPORT**

**On motion by Mrs. Boujoukos, seconded by Mr. Shuckrow, the Board approved Items I through III as contained in the Special Meeting Board Folder and as listed below:**

**I. Agreement Between North Allegheny School District and Allegheny Intermediate Unit**

The Board approved the Letter of Agreement between the North Allegheny School District and the Allegheny Intermediate Unit to provide travel instruction services at the rate of \$80.00 per hour for the first 25 hours, and at the rate of \$60.00 per hour for all additional hours. This Agreement is in effect for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

**II. Agreement Between North Allegheny School District and Wesley Spectrum Academy**

The Board approved the Services Agreement between the North Allegheny School District and Wesley Spectrum Academy for three students to attend the private therapeutic academic program. This Agreement is for the 2009/2010 school year and the tuition is \$21,740 per student for a full academic year.

**III. Agreement Between North Allegheny School District and Watson Institute**

The Board approved the Letter of Agreement between the North Allegheny School District and the Watson Institute for one student to attend the Watson Institute School-based Cyber Academy (WISCA) program for the 2009/2010 school year. Tuition for the program is \$35,000 per student for a full academic year.

**Keystone Exams** – **Mr. Shuckrow** asked the group if they feel there is any additional action that the Board should take to demonstrate opposition to the Keystone Exams. Our District has been very active in expressing its opposition of the Keystone Exams by numerous letters to legislators and other public officials and direct testimony at Hearings by the Superintendent. **Mrs. Grosheider** indicated that she feels that there is still an opportunity to defeat this movement and the Board should move forward with some action. She feels that the State Board made a grievous error in supporting these exams and feels that it is the wrong thing to do for students. Others agreed. Various strategies were discussed, including ways to collaborate with local Districts in this effort. **Mr. Shuckrow** will coordinate this project.

**Mural in Gym at NAI** - **Mrs. Ludwig** mentioned that she saw the mural painted in the gym at NAI by Dave Hawbaker. Mr. Hawbaker is widely known for his skill in designing and painting murals and she encouraged the Board to stop by and see the beautiful results of his efforts in the gym at NAI.
