SCHEDULING TIMELINE 2009 - 2010

March 11 – March 13	NAI School Counselors meet with 9th grade classes, distribute Program of Studies and personalize student course recommendation/verification reports.
March 11 – March 13	Middle School Counselors distribute individual schedule folders including course recommendation sheets in 8th grade classes.
March 13	NASH School Counselors meet with 10th grade classes, distribute Program of Studies and personalize student course recommendation/verification reports.
March 16	NAI holds scheduling meetings with parents of 8th and 9th graders. (9:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. in the NAI Auditorium)
March 16	Parent informational meeting for IMPACT program. (9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the NAI Library)
March 16 – March 27	PSSA administered (Reading and Math).
March 18	NASH School Counselors meet with all 11th grade students to distribute Program of Studies and personalized course recommendation/verification sheets.
March 23 and 24	NASH holds scheduling meetings with parents of 10th and 11th graders. (6:00 p.m.)
April 3	NAI students return course recommendation/verification sheets to science teachers.
April 3	All 11th grade student schedule requests due in School Counseling Office.
April 7	End of Third Nine weeks.
April 15 - 17	NAI School Counselors meet with students to review schedule requests in NAI Library.
April 21 - 23	NAI School Counselors visit middle schools to discuss scheduling process with individual students: CMS - April 21 MMS - April 22 IMS - April 23
May 1	All waivers due to respective School Counseling Offices - grades 8 through 11.
August 14	Mail student schedules (NASH/NAI).
August 27, 2009	School begins.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

SUMMARY FOR ALL CLASSES

Class of 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013 (current 8th, 9th, 10th & 11th graders)

At North Allegheny, a minimum of 21.5 credits is required for graduation from high school. These credits must include:

English	4.0 credits (includes culminating project)
Social Studies	4.0 credits
Mathematics	3.0 credits
Science	3.0 credits
Physical Education (.5) credit per year	2.0 credits
Health Education	.5 credits
Arts & Humanities Electives	2.0 credits
Other Electives	3.0 credits
Total Credits	21.5 credits

In addition to the 21.5 credit requirement, students must demonstrate mastery of the Pennsylvania Academic Standards on the culminating 11th grade Pennsylvania State System of Assessment (PSSA). Mastery shall be deemed as attaining a score of Proficient or higher on the 11th grade PSSA or 12th grade PSSA Retest, attaining passing grade(s) on a local assessment aligned to the PA Academic Standards as designed or selected by the District, or fulfilling requirements of a graduation plan on a student's IEP.

Scheduling Requirements for All Students . . .

1. At least 2.0 credits of Elective Courses must be acquired in the Arts and Humanities. Arts and Humanities courses include additional courses in English, Social Studies, World Languages, Visual Arts, Family and Consumer Sciences, Technology Education, and Music Arts.

2. Students must schedule a minimum number of credits each year:

Grade 9 - 7.0 credits

Grade 11 - 6.5 credits

Grade 10 - 6.5 credits

Grade 12 - 6.5 credits

Students who deviate from this requirement must have the approval of the Building Principal.

3. Successful completion of a minimum of 10 credits is required to achieve junior standing. Students with deficiencies in English, Social Studies, Math or Science will require a review in order to be eligible for full-time enrollment at the Senior High School.
4. There are eight (8) instructional periods at the Intermediate High School and Senior High School. Students are encouraged to take advantage of the many and varied elective courses offered by the District.
5. During any semester students should not have more than two (2) study halls per day.
