Pol. 003	<p style="text-align: center;">003.1 - <u>ADVISORY COMMITTEES TO THE BOARD</u></p> <p>Section 1. <u>Advisory Committees</u></p> <p>The North Allegheny School Board will rely on various advisory committees to counsel it as one means of discerning the needs and desires of the North Allegheny School District and its residents. The central purpose of all advisory committees is to contribute to the educational program by conducting studies, identifying problems and developing recommendations that will enhance the effectiveness of the decision making process. The ultimate authority to make decisions will continue to reside in the powers and duties of the School Board as imposed by law.</p> <p>Section 2. <u>The Citizens' Advisory Committee</u></p> <p>a. The Citizens' Advisory Committee is a committee of this nature consisting of no fewer than 20 members. The Board shall have the power in its sole discretion to temporarily increase the size of the committee when the nature, scope and complexity of the subject matter said committee is to act upon makes such increase advisable.</p> <p>b. The Citizens' Advisory Committee shall act in an advisory capacity to the School Board and shall have no decision-making power. The committee's duties shall be to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide two-way communications between the citizens and the Board for the benefit of the school-community. • Inform the Board of the views of the citizens on matters of current interest. • Provide facts, information, opinions and recommendations which would be helpful to the Board.
