

Keystone Exam Retest

Frequently Asked Questions:

What time should I arrive on the test date?

Students should report to the cafeteria at the North Allegheny Senior High School on July 30th at 8:45a.m.

What should I bring with me on the day of the test?

Students should bring #2 pencils and a calculator.

I can't come to the test date, why didn't North Allegheny School District provide this information earlier?

This is information that was just released from the Pennsylvania Department of Education last week.

What can my child do to prepare for the test?

Instructional resources are listed on the IMS website under the column labeled "Announcements".

What if my child cannot attend?

There will be additional opportunities to retest next year.

Will my child have to be in the remedial course?

If your child did not pass the test, some type of supplemental instruction is required. The [letter](#) sent to each family outlines the options depending on your child's performance level.

My child won't be comfortable testing with high school students. Why can't they give this test at Ingomar Middle School?

The district has only one testing location for this retest. However, students will be assigned to a classroom with other students from the same school. Your child will not be testing with high school students.

When will we get the results?

No exact date has been announced. We expect that results will arrive in the fall after the school year has begun.
