North Allegheny Foundation Fall Grants Period is Open!



The Basics

North Allegheny Foundation has two grants submission periods per year: one in the fall and one in the spring. The Foundation's mission is to enhance and enrich the educational experience at North Allegheny, and we're looking for grants to support our mission!



Who can apply for a grant?

If you are a North Allegheny School District staff member, you can apply!



When are applications due?

Applications are open now through October 8.

What kind of things can I use grant money for?

As long as it supports the Foundation's mission, there are no restrictions! We have approved grants for 3D printers, school gardens, adapted bikes for HPE classes, an automated milling machine, a student ambassador program, STEM building kits for libraries, and much more. In general, classroom furniture grants are usually not approved. Try to show how your project will impact as many students as possible and a clear connection to enhancing the curriculum. Collaborating with your colleagues can be helpful!



How much are the grants for?

There are no restrictions here, either. The Foundation has approved grants from a few hundred dollars up to thousands of dollars.



How do you determine which grant applications get approved?

When considering grant applications, the Foundation uses a three-question rubric:

- Does this grant support North Allegheny's Strategic Goals?
- What is the level of impact of this grant on schools and classrooms?
- Does this grant fit with the NA Foundation's mission?



If I get a grant, how long will it take to get the money?

Once the submission window closes on October 8, the Foundation will review the applications and send their recommendations to the Board of School Directors for approval at their November 20 meeting. After the Board approves the recommended grants, notification emails and checks will go out within two weeks. All applicants will receive an email notification with the decision on their grant.
