NORTH ALLEGHENY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL - Driving/Parking/Riding Regulations THE NORTH ALLEGHENY SCHOOL DISTRICT STRONGLY RECOMMENDS THAT STUDENTS USE THE DISTRICT PROVIDED BUS TRANSPORTATION

The Administration expects all parents/guardians and students to read and comply with all the rules and regulations if they choose NOT to use District provided transportation. There must be a legitimate need to drive, and reasons must be specified on the reverse side of this form. DRIVING A VEHICLE IS A SERIOUS RESPONSIBILITY. THE DISTRICT WILL NOT HESITATE TO REVOKE A STUDENT'S DRIVING/RIDING PRIVILEGES FOR ANY IRRESPONSIBLE BEHAVIOR. The school provides security but cannot be responsible for accidents, theft, or vandalism in the parking lot. There are no warnings given for infractions. Consequences are clearly outlined on the reverse side and in the Student Handbook. Students must bring a current driver's license and registration card for each vehicle to be registered. Applications will not be processed unless the student appears in person to complete necessary documents.

- 1. All vehicles a student may drive must be registered. *THE PERMIT MUST BE CLEARLY DISPLAYED ON THE REAR VIEW MIRROR WHILE ENTERING AND WHILE PARKED ON SCHOOL GROUNDS.*
- 2. Interchanging permits with other students is prohibited.
- 3. Permission for riders will be the responsibility of the drivers' and riders' parents/guardians. Each rider must be properly seat belted.
- 4. Students must drive safely (a **15-mph speed limit** sign is posted on school grounds) and must obey all traffic signs. <u>No students are permitted to enter or exit parking lots by rear of school roadway or immediately in front of the school during the regular school day.</u>
- 5. Students must park their cars <u>BETWEEN WHITE LINES</u> in the parking lot at the south end of the building, or in the tennis court parking lot. <u>Regardless of circumstances (inclement weather, etc.)</u>, <u>students may not park their cars in irregular parking patterns</u>, in the red zones, or in handicap spaces.
- 6. Students are not allowed to be in the parking lot at any time during the school day without written authorization from an administrator. Hall passes may not be used for the parking lot.
- 7. If a student is tardy because of traffic congestion, it is considered an *unexcused tardy*. Student drivers should allow ample time to drive to school and be in their first period classes on time.
- 8. Car trouble that results in tardiness or absenteeism is not an excused absence.
- 9. Any behavior involving student drivers or riders that threaten the security or safety of students and vehicles will be dealt with firmly. Students' cars may not be moved from one place to another during the school day without authorization.
- 10. Students are requested not to drive after a snowstorm unless necessary.
- 11. Driving privileges will be immediately revoked if/when the District becomes aware of a student being cited for any serious violation. All violations are subject to review.
- 12. Daily permits are available (at a cost of \$1.00) with written permission from the parent/guardian, and by reporting to the office and recording name, date, license #, and make of car. A one-day permit will be issued and **MUST BE DISPLAYED ON THE REAR VIEW MIRROR.** Students are still required to be in first period class on time.
- 13. Any unauthorized/unregistered vehicles can/will be towed or detained at the owner's expense.
- 14. <u>STUDENTS MUST YIELD THE RIGHT OF WAY TO BUSES AND TO ANY PEDESTRIAN AT MARKED</u> CROSSWALKS.
- 15. Students may only drive vehicles that are registered by the school under their name. Students may not drive another student's vehicle on school property.
- 16. Student drivers or passengers smoking/vaping in vehicles on school property is prohibited and will be considered a major offense.
- 17. Any student turning left into the tennis court entrance from Route 19 or turning left from the tennis court entrance onto Route 19 will lose their parking driving permit for 90 days. This is a serious safety violation. There will be no opportunity to pay a fine in lieu of losing your parking driving privileges for 90 days.
- 18. STUDENTS MUST OBEY ALL "ONE WAY" TRAFFIC SIGNS.
