Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures

- Rear entrance doors lock at 8:10 am if doors are locked, report to main office.
- If you are dropping your child off after 8:10 a.m., drive up to the entrance and drop off your child with a note.
- If you are picking your child up during the school day, you will need to pull up to main entrance after sending email/note or call ahead to sign your child out. <u>Any adult other than</u> <u>parent/guardian needs to be communicated to the main</u> <u>office.</u>
- If you are picking your child up at the end of the day, the last pick up in the office is at 2:30. After 2:30, your child can be picked up at the back of the school within the pick up line.


iPad Devices-Educational Tools
