## Math Waiver Procedure

- Communication is initiated by the parent and student to the appropriate teacher.
- If a waiver contract is desired after communication with the teacher, the waiver form is given to the student by the student's current teacher.
- Current 6th and 7th graders <u>MUST</u> complete their waivers for math on or before <u>May 27th</u> and submit to the counseling office.
