Math Waiver Procedure

- Communication is initiated by the parent and student to the appropriate teacher.
- If a waiver contract is desired after communication with the teacher, the waiver form is given to the student by the student's current teacher.
- Current 6th and 7th graders MUST complete their waivers for math on or before May 26th and submit to the counseling office.

- Counselors in classrooms to discuss and distribute World Language Letters/Change Music Form
 - February 14 & 15
- *DUE DATE * Students are to return World Language/Change Music Form to HOMEROOM teacher with parent signature by February 24th
- May 26- Last day to submit <u>math</u> waivers to the Counseling Office for 6th and 7th graders.
