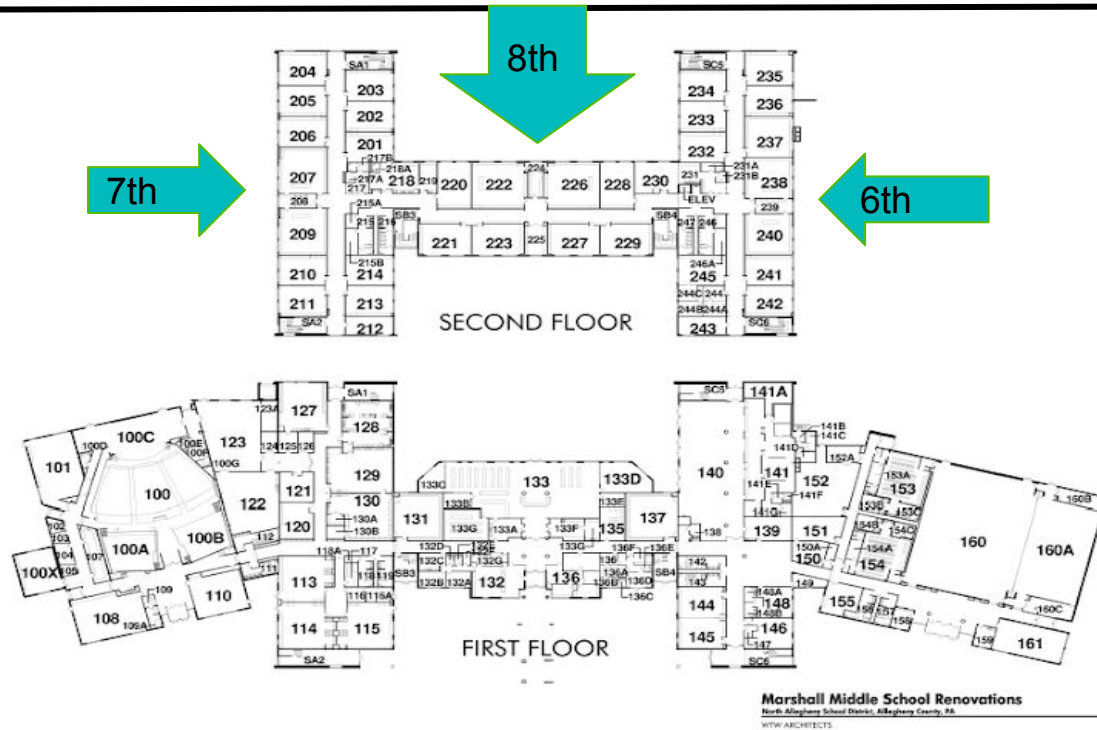

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS)

- Marshall Middle School is a certified PBIS school. During the 2022 summer, a committee of MMS staff were trained by the Allegheny Intermediate Unit.

What is PBIS

- an evidence based, tiered framework for supporting students' behavioral, academic, social, and emotional wellbeing.

MMS Implementation

- SPARK the Difference Expectations and rollout to all grade levels.
- Introduction of SPARK tickets to incentivize positive behavior.
- Specific focus on unstructured areas (hallway, cafeteria, etc.)
