<input type="checkbox"/> Register for final ACT, SAT, or ASVAB tests. A lot of schools will still accept the September or October test scores for early deadlines.	<input type="checkbox"/> Know your application deadlines, and make sure you have your correct deadlines listed in your Naviance account.	<input type="checkbox"/> Check your NA email often. Most communication surrounding applications and post secondary choices happens via email.
<input type="checkbox"/> Review your transcript for accuracy. Read and complete the Transcript Release Form found on the NASH School Counseling site.	<input type="checkbox"/> Meet with your school counselor to discuss your post high school plans and if you need a counselor letter of recommendation.	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete Counselor and/or Teacher Letter of Recommendation Forms if you need letters written. Submit these forms at least 2 weeks in advance.
<input type="checkbox"/> If you are submitting scores, request and pay for official test scores through the testing websites.	<input type="checkbox"/> Request transcripts be sent to the schools to which you are applying via Naviance. You MUST mark how you applied in your Naviance account.	<input type="checkbox"/> Invite your teachers to submit your letters of recommendation via your Naviance account. Provide at least a 2 week notice.
<input type="checkbox"/> Complete the student portion of your applications and submit when they are completed. You do not have to wait for letters of rec or transcripts to submit.	<input type="checkbox"/> You can begin to complete the FAFSA in December of your senior year.	<input type="checkbox"/> Attend Financial Aid Night presentation at NASH.
<input type="checkbox"/> Explore the scholarship list on Naviance and apply for any scholarships that fit you.	<input type="checkbox"/> Visit the schools to which you have been accepted. A lot of places offer Accepted Student Days. Talk to recruiters if interested in military options.	<input type="checkbox"/> Make your post high school choice. If it's college, compare your school acceptance offers to determine the best fit for you academically and financially.
<input type="checkbox"/> Register, prepare for, and take any AP tests relevant to your schedule.	<input type="checkbox"/> For college, send in your tuition deposit to your school of choice by May 1.	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete the NA graduation survey found on Naviance. If you are attending college, you MUST mark which school is to receive your final transcript.
