Players are placed in the appropriate skill level tier based on player evaluations so they can compete safely and remain competitive while building their skills. Evaluations consist of skating and shooting drills in addition to scrimmaging. All skill levels are welcome.

## WHAT IS INLINE HOCKEY?

- It is played on roller blades instead of ice skates.
- 4 skaters and a goalie per side.
- Fast paced and high scoring. No icing or off sides.
- No checking
- Learn from coaches who have played at the collegiate level.
- Season lasts from September to March with playoffs.
- One practice per week with weekend games.
- Teams tiered for appropriate grade and skill levels.
- Annual scholarship awarded to a graduating senior.
- Local rinks only. No travel.
- Home rink is the RMU Island Sports Complex

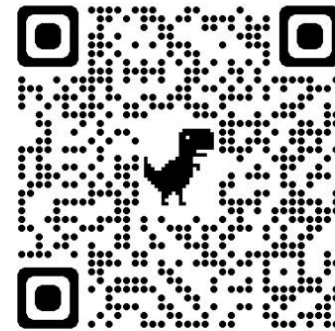
