WHEN I GET HOME...

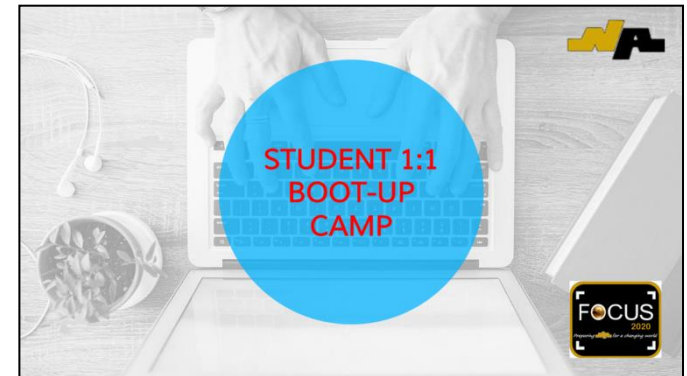
- 1** Open the box to ensure that I have all of the parts. This box includes:
