001 - NAME AND CLASSIFICATION

Section 1. Name

The North Allegheny School District is a District of the Second Class governed by a Board of nine (9) elected School Directors. The School District’s fiscal year shall begin on the first day of July of each year.

The official name of the North Allegheny School Board (hereinafter designated the “Board”) is the North Allegheny School Board, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and such title shall be employed in executing all agreements to which the Board is a party, and in signing all papers requiring the signature of the Board.

Section 2. Composition

The North Allegheny School District is composed of the Boroughs of Bradford Woods and Franklin Park, the Town of McCandless, and Marshall Township.

Section 3. Purpose

The North Allegheny School District is organized for the purpose of inspiring excellence in academics, athletics, arts, and activities for every student every day and to provide a program of public education to serve the needs of the students residing in the North Allegheny School District.

Section 4. Intermediate Unit

The North Allegheny School District is assigned to Allegheny Intermediate Unit No. 3.

Section 5. Classification

The North Allegheny School District is classified as a school district of the second class.
