107 - ADOPTION OF PLANNED INSTRUCTION

Section 1. Purpose

The Board shall provide a comprehensive program of planned instruction to enable District students to achieve educational objectives and attain academic standards required for student achievement. Planned instruction shall consist of at least the following:

- a. Unit-based curriculum including essential concepts and key learner objectives.
- b. Resources including materials, activities, textbooks, and online options.
- c. Recognition of established academic standards.
- d. Procedure for assessment of attainment of objectives and academic standards.

Section 2. Authority

The Board must adopt any planned course of instruction, by majority vote, prior to being taught in the District.

Section 3. Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent shall be responsible for continuous evaluation of the effectiveness of the District’s planned instruction and shall recommend to the Board new and/or revised planned instruction deemed to be in the best interests of District students.

The Superintendent must maintain a current list of all planned instruction and furnish copies to the Board upon request.
