115 - CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Section 1. Authority

SC 1806, 1807
Title 22
Sec. 339.2, 4.31, 12.41

- a. The Board shall provide a program for the option of career and technical education in order to:
 - 1. Prepare students for employment as skilled workers or technicians in recognized, new, and emerging occupations;
 - 2. Prepare students for enrollment in post-secondary education programs; and
 - 3. Assist students in choosing career pathways.
- b. All students participating in career and technical programs sponsored or supervised by the Board shall be considered regularly enrolled in District schools and shall be subject to Board policies and District administrative regulations and rules.
- c. The Board shall support a program for career and technical education which may include:
 - 1. District students attending the designated career and technical center for participation in a cooperative program of career development.
 - 2. Career and technical courses of study interwoven and articulated throughout the curriculum of District schools.
- d. Students and parent(s)/guardian(s) shall be informed that admission to career and technical education programs is accessible to regularly enrolled District students, in accordance with established criteria for attendance.
