**139 - NORTH ALLEGHENY SCHOOL DISTRICT
SCHOOL AGE CHILD CARE**

Section 1. Purpose

The school age before and after school childcare program will provide students with a supervised, extended school day experience of social, recreational, arts, and other interests. The program may be offered to students attending the North Allegheny School District in grades K-5 (A.M. kindergarten, before school only; P.M. kindergarten, after school only).

Section 2. Delegation of Responsibility

The School Board's approval of a provider shall be through a selection process designed by the office of the Superintendent to obtain programs most favorable to the children and their parents and to establish the best rates obtainable.

Section 3. Guidelines

- a. The school age child care program may be offered under the following conditions:
 - 1. The Supervisor of Elementary Education has determined through investigation of the extracurricular and inter/intra school athletic activities that there is sufficient space available to house the program. Considerations for space availability will be determined annually and the District shall maintain a thirty (30) day notification provision within the contract should building needs necessitate changes in requirements for space usage.
 - 2. The before and after school program shall be for school age children and shall be housed in selected, active District elementary school buildings before and after school hours by a service provider through a contract with the School District and in accordance with School Board Policy 707.
 - 3. The program shall be made available to all students in accordance with Title VI, Title IX, and Section 504: Affirmative Action Program for

The program shall be monitored by the Supervisor of Elementary Education.</p> <p>c. The program shall be provided by private, public, nonprofit, and/or for-profit organization(s) licensed by the State of Pennsylvania, Department of Public Welfare, as day-care providers through the District's standard contract for such services. Contracts will be awarded on a competitive rate basis upon recommendation of the Superintendent or designee.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The program shall be operated solely by the provider as an independent contractor and not as an agent of the School District.2.
