Beginners are students entering the lowest grade of the primary school above the Kindergarten level. A beginner is eligible for admission to the lowest grade of the primary school above the Kindergarten level if s/he has attained the age of six (6) on or before September 1.b. Early Admission to First Grade<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students who are born after September 1 and before October 31 are eligible for early admission testing upon request to the building principal.2. All requests must be made prior to August 1 of the year of enrollment.3. Testing must be completed two weeks before the start of the school year.4. Early admission shall be considered upon meeting all of the following criteria:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The child must obtain a minimum score of 127 on an individual intelligence test.• The child must demonstrate social and emotional age equivalences of seven (7) years on adaptive behavior scales.• The child must demonstrate advanced academic preparedness for First Grade as measured through math and reading assessments.5. Testing will be conducted by the District school psychologist at no cost to the parent(s)/guardian(s)6. A recommendation for approval for early admission will be made by the Superintendent or designee pending the completion and submission of all assessments and paperwork.7.
