705 - SAFETY

Section 1. Purpose

The Board recognizes that District facilities must be maintained and operated in a condition that is safe for students, staff, and visitors.

Section 2. Authority

The Board directs that a District-wide health safety program shall be established and maintained to ensure a safe and secure environment for all students, staff, and visitors, as well as to protect District buildings, equipment, and property. The safety program shall provide: instruction for students and staff in safety and accident prevention; protective devices where they are required for safety; and suitable and safe equipment necessary for the conduct of the educational programs and operation of the schools.

Section 3. Delegation of Responsibility

a. The Superintendent or designee shall develop school safety protocols that address school safety issues, prevention of accidents and fire, and includes applicable requirements of law and regulations.

The Superintendent or designee shall:

1. Ensure instruction to students in safety and fire prevention
2. Provide required drills and instruct students in safety procedures

b. Administrators or designee shall inform all staff and students of safety protocols.

c. Any unsafe condition or practice brought to the attention of an employee shall be reported to the building administrator and head custodian.

Section 4. Guidelines

The District shall continually study and develop safety practices and procedures.

- a. The Superintendent or designee shall create and adopt classroom, building-level, and District-wide procedures that address all hazards. A process for standardization of these procedures shall also be created and adopted.
- b. Health and Safety Committee:

The Board directs the establishment of a Health and Safety Committee to provide leadership in accomplishing the following objectives:

1. To create an accident-free environment by implementing safety protocols through employee awareness, training, and self-inspections
2. To prevent losses from fire by identifying, evaluating, and correcting safety hazards
3. To provide a clean, safe, and hazard-free environment for all students and staff
