**904 - PUBLIC ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL EVENTS**

**Section 1. Purpose**

The Board welcomes the public at activities and events sponsored by the District, but the Board also acknowledges its duty to maintain order and preserve school facilities during such events.

**Section 2. Authority**

- a. The Board has the authority to prohibit at a school event the attendance of any individual whose conduct may constitute a disruption.
- b. The Board prohibits gambling, other than authorized small games of chance, and the possession and use of controlled substances, alcoholic beverages, and weapons on school premises.

**Section 3. Guidelines**

- a. Tobacco Use
  - 1. The Board prohibits tobacco use by any persons in its school buildings and on any property, buses, vans, and vehicles that are owned, leased, or controlled by the District.
  - 2. The District shall annually notify staff, parent(s)/guardian(s) and members of the public about the District's tobacco use policy by publishing such in handbooks, newsletters, posted notices, and other efficient methods.
- b. Senior citizens who are District residents and are sixty (60) years of age or older shall be given a senior citizen guest pass to attend without charge all school home athletic events.
- c. Individuals with disabilities may be accompanied by their service animals while on District property for events that are open to the general public in accordance with Board policy and state and federal law and regulation.
